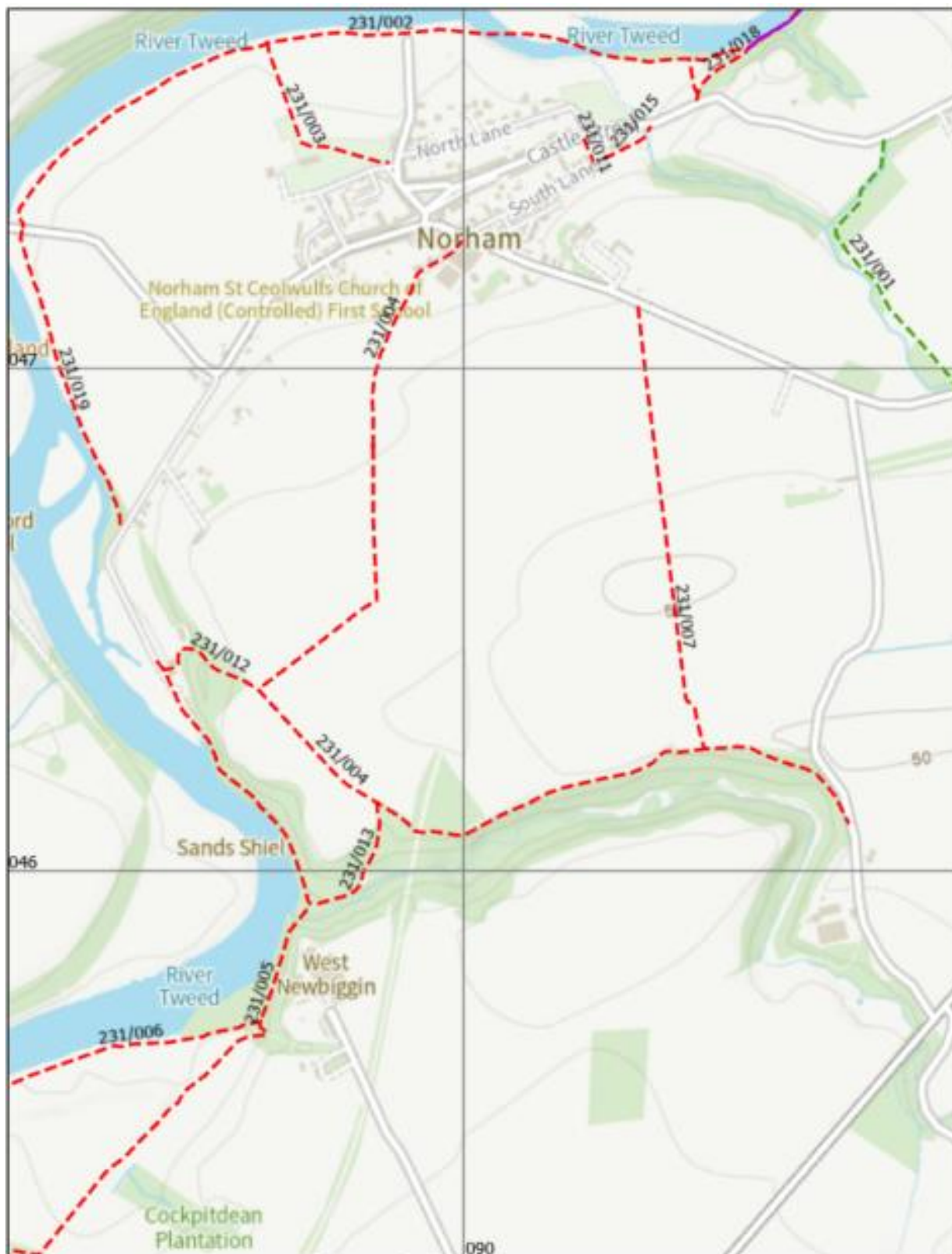
In reply to your consultation regarding the above Scoping Opinion for a single wind turbine at Land South Of Norham Village And North Of Newbiggin Dean, Norham, Northumberland.

I enclose a plan showing the routes of Public Footpaths No. 4 & 7, marked in red, where they pass through and adjacent to the proposed development site respectively.

I draw your attention to the position of the Public Rights of Way network within the proposed development site. The EIA for the development should consider what impact the proposal may have on public rights of way and access by the public during the construction and operational phases of the project. Where an impact on the public right of way is identified and/or public access could be affected, the EIA should explain what mitigation measures and/or temporary closures or diversions are proposed.
